

Public Concern Over Library Materials

The Library is aware that some materials owned by the Library may be offensive to some individuals. The choice of library materials is an individual matter. While a person may reject materials for oneself, he or she may not restrict access to these materials by others.

In the event a patron complains about a particular material, they should be encouraged to complete a “Statement of Concern About Library Resources” form and give it to the Library Director/Adult Services Librarian, or the Youth Services Librarian who will reply to the patron’s complaint. In all cases, the Librarian should try to find the review for the material to back up the decision to purchase the item, and shall also go over the Collection development Policy with the patron. If the patron is not satisfied after talking to the appropriate librarian, then the issue shall go before the Board.
