Monday, May 9, 2022**

Call to Order: Sara Talbot called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

Friends Report: Tina gave short report.

Minutes of Previous Meeting: Tracy Knavel moved to accept the minutes of the April meeting. Marsha Long seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Programming: Our mid-day craft this month was painted rock cacti. It was fun and well-attended. Chair Yoga has dropped off somewhat in attendance, but we still have a decent crowd who attend regularly. The American Red Cross taught an Emergency Preparedness class on May 19, attended by 12 teens and adults. Library staff are ramping up for Summer Reading, this year's theme being "Oceans of Possibilities."

Anniversary: Sharry Semans handed out 150 flowers to the community on Saturday, May 21. Thank you to Sharry and Lynn for organizing this event. Our patrons really enjoyed receiving a flower when they came to the library that day. We have registered 65 new library cards this year, out of our goal of 150.

Tax Referendum: The tax referendum passed with 88% support! The final vote was 499-71. Thank you to staff, trustees, and Friends who worked tirelessly to educate the community about

why this funding was needed. This was a huge voter turnout, both in comparison with our surrounding communities as well as previous years.

Grants: I've written and submitted a grant application to the F.T. and Anna C. Manley Memorial Fund for virtual meeting equipment. The grant application includes two OWL meeting cameras, a smart TV, and four virtual reality headsets.

Community: The Cuba-Rushford Seniors participated in a Community Service Day on May 31. We were fortunate to be included in this service. Seniors repainted our sidewalk obstacle course (thank you, Wendy Sprague, for cleaning off the old one) and weeded our flower beds.

Youth Services Monthly Report: May 2022

Storytimes

We had 5 preschool storytimes. We did a mix of STEAM activities and crafts. We also went on a picnic to Chamberlain Park for an extra fun adventure. For the last storytime for this school year, I promoted summer reading a little by reading some ocean books and doing a sink/float activity outside. We had one toddler storytime. Low attendance for that age group this year has been discouraging but hopefully it will pick back up through summer storytimes and carry over into the fall.

K-3 Group

After school also did a mix of STEAM and crafts. We had a paper airplane building competition. One week, several students were out, whether for illness or other activities so there were only 3 girls present. We did a casual craft day, which was a big hit. For the last week of afterschool, we got out the Sphero robots and Osmo kits and had stations. We wrapped the afternoon up with ice cream sundaes.

Teens/Tweens

We had a board game night for each age group. Two teen boys came to the teen night and learned a new (to them) strategy game. The tween night had nine children in attendance. They had a lot of fun.

Outreach

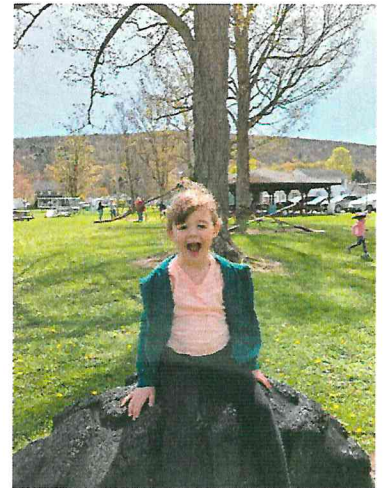

Disaster Plan Committee Meeting

May 23, 2022

Tina Dalton, Wendy Sprague and Sharry Semans met on May 23, 2022, to continue preparation of a Disaster Plan.

Tina is in the process of preparing a "Building Book", which includes info on the electrical system, plumbing, heating, and everything else you can think of regarding the building. There are emergency phone numbers, and people to call in whatever situation occurs. When it is done, there will be a lot of info in one place, and it will be a very useful resource for us. She is doing a fabulous job.

We decided that the Disaster Plan will be merged with this book. We have also decided to stock up with some emergency equipment, which will be in a tote, in the small storage room next to the front door. We have a lot of the equipment to put in the tote, but Tina will need to purchase some items that we do not have, i.e., battery operated radio, protective glasses, a crowbar, etc.

Tina will apply to Documentary Heritage and Preservation Services for New York to assist us in creating an inventory of books and other items which are hard to replace, and help us with preservation resources. Tina will work directly with them.

We will require the assistance of our new maintenance person to look at issues such as electrical boxes being easily accessible, windows are properly sealed, etc. This will become part of an annual review for our maintenance person. These reviews will also be put in the book.

In addition, once this plan is operational, staff will be trained in the use of fire extinguishers, and perhaps CPR.

Once Tina has the info from Preservation Services, we will meet again.
